

Make Your Own Picture Book

A 12-page kit for ages 4–9. Print it, staple it, and let a child publish an actual book this afternoon.

What's inside

1 book cover · 1 character sheet · 1 story planner · 8 story pages · 1 about-the-author page · 1 published-author certificate

How to use it

1. Print single-sided on any paper.
2. Do the character sheet first — a hero the child invents beats a hero you suggest.
3. Fill the planner before drawing. Three sentences is a whole plot at this age.
4. Draw first, write second. Writing to a picture is easier than picturing what you wrote.
5. Staple down the left edge and read it out loud together. Sign the certificate.

If the drawing is the blocker

Some children have the story but stall at the illustration and quit. If that's yours, they can describe the story instead and get it illustrated at **www.doodara.com** — free, in the browser, no account needed — then print it and keep going with this kit.

There are also 31 finished books to read for free, no sign-up, at **www.doodara.com/template-books** — useful as a read-aloud model before a child writes their own.
